where all the veins meet yeah,

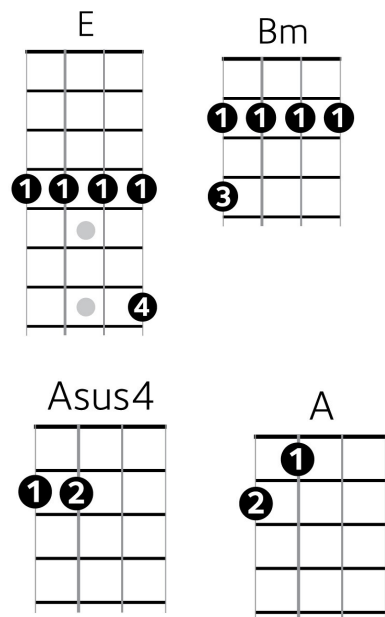
