

Fly Like A Bird

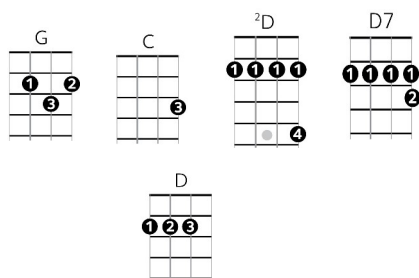
