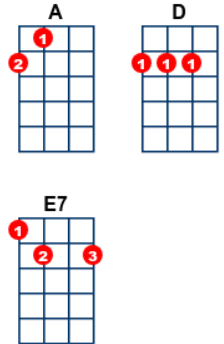


Me and Bobby McGee
