Never thinking of myself

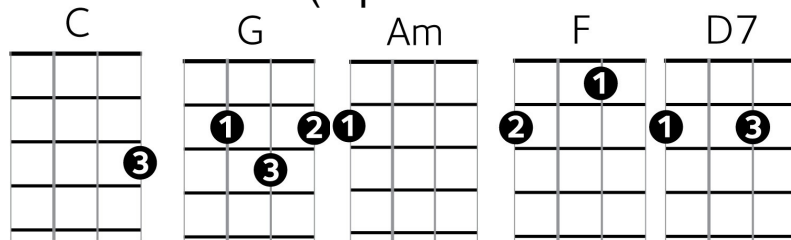
Verse 2
