And a [Am] scrubbing brush next [F] to a note


That said, [C] 'Use these [G] down to your bones' [Am] [F]

And [C] before I knew I had [G] shiny skin



And [Am] it felt easy being [F] clean like him

I thought [C] this one knows [G] better than I [Am] do [F]


Prechorus [Dm] A triangle trying to [F] squeeze through a circle [G] /
