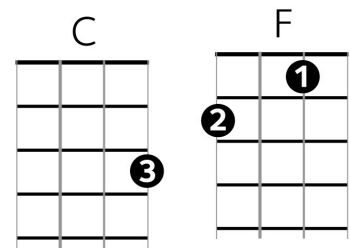


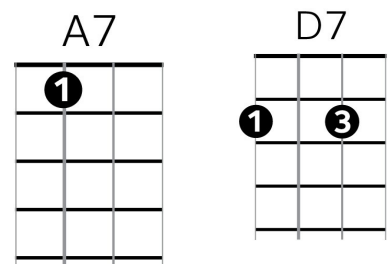
Side By Side parody (original 1927 by Gus Kahn & Harry M. Woods)

(parody author unknown, but it wasn't Bob Beale)

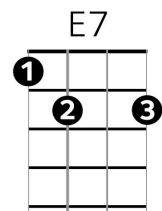
[C] Oh we got married last [F] Fri-[C]-day

 [D7] Side [G7] by [C] side



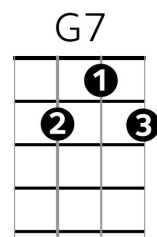
We were so happily [F] wed [C] when
