Verse 1

God, I feel like hell tonight

Verse 2

Nothing's true and nothing's right
So let me be alone tonight
'Cause you can't change the way I
am
Are you strong enough to be my
man?

<p>Chorus (bracketed chords are 'bounce' chords before the next one)</p> <p>Em G Lie to me (A)-Bm (C)-G I promise I'll believe (A)-Em G Lie to me (A)-Bm (C)-G (A)-D (back to chordal riff) But please don't leave</p>

Verse 3

I have a face I cannot show
I make the rules up as I go
Just try and love me if you can
Are you strong enough to be my
man?

Bridge

The Bridge is an interlude on the main chord riff with a chant/exchange between *My man* and *Are you strong enough?*

Verse 4

When I've shown you that I just
don't care
When I'm throwing punches in the
air
When I'm broken down and I can't
stand
Would you be man enough to be
my man?

Repeat Chorus and finish on a D
