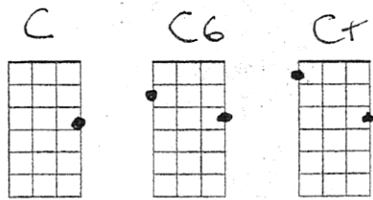

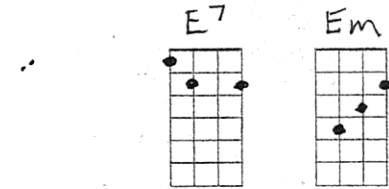

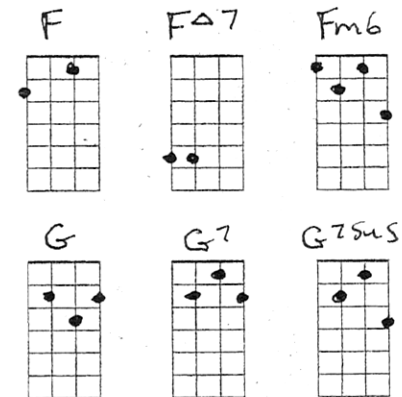
VERSE 1

And I think to myself what a wonderful world



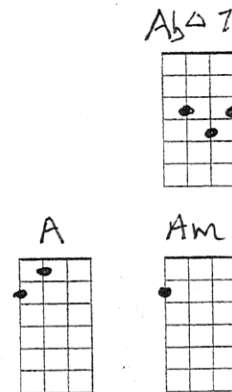
VERSE 2

And I think to myself what a wonderful world



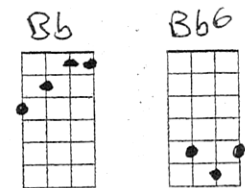
BRIDGE
